### **DISASTER RISK REDUCTION**

College Sanjauli in collaboration with State Disaster Management Authority and DOER organized a training programme on Disaster Risk Reduction on 16<sup>th</sup> August 20<sup>th</sup> August and 21<sup>st</sup> August 2018. The chief guest was Dr. Sadhna Thakur chairperson of Hospital Welfare Society; wife of Honourable Chief Minister arrived at sharp 10AM to grace the occasion. DR CB Mehta principal; of college welcomed the chief guest after lighting the lamp in front of Saraswati Maa. DR GP Kapoor head of Disaster Management Cell and of Red cross expresses her views about three days training programme along with its implications. She also welcomes the chief guest and principal along with other dignitaries on the dais. She elucidated the role of SDMA and Disaster Management Act of 2005.



DR. Sadhna Thakur shared her thoughts about disaster management and explained its importance to the students. She appreciated the steps taken by administration along with SDMA. She advised the students to take this training seriously so that they can carry this skill throughout their life time. They were directed to use their learnt skill in the society at the needy time. Then they can be assets to the state as well as the nation which is the need of the hour. Because Man made disasters like road accident, land slides,

After having tea DR GP Kapoor made her presentation on overall view of disaster management of HP. She narrated all possibilities of man-made and natural disasters of HP. She also explained the basic concepts of hazard, vulnerability, risk, pre disaster preparedness during and after disaster how rehabilitation should be established.

***FOLLOWING WERE THE KEY HIGHLIGHTS COVERED IN THIS PROGRAMME:-***

1. Overview of Disaster Management and Disaster profile of HP.

2. Understanding Hazard and Disaster: HRVC Analysis; Responsive and Non Responsive Preparedness for Disaster ; Uses of Tools in Disaster Management.

3. Key consideration for child focused Psychological care during event of Disaster with practical Exercises.

4. Fire Risk Mitigation & Management , Basics of search and rescue operations followed by practical demonstration regarding Evacuation, Transportation & Fire Fighting. Basics of First aid with practical demonstration .

5. College Disaster Management Plan: Need , Framework and Process followed by Group work.

On 16<sup>th</sup> August Mr. Navneet Yadav Associate chairperson of DOERS told us about HAZARD and DISASTER and how to react when some disaster occur . He told us about the use of ICT in disasters.

On 20<sup>th</sup> August morning session was given by Miss Nidhi DOER members. Practically they told us about the psychosocio care during disaster and about various impacts of disasters . They formed various groups and told them to write about the different impacts of disasters. In the evening session Mr. Jagdish Sharma CFO and Mr. DC Sharma imparted volunteers about fire and how to deal with it. They also share some first Aid knowledge with volunteers and practically showed how to use different extinguishers for different fire.

On 21<sup>st</sup> August in the morning session Dr. Shonim from IGMC showed PPT on medical first aid and about its basics and told about the same to volunteers . In the evening session Mr. Navneet Yadav told about disaster plan and for this four groups were
